#### Cinema

The UK Cinema Association (previously known as the Cinema Exhibitors' Association) provides a card which allows a carer to accompany a child or adult with SEND to the cinema at no extra cost. A child must be aged 5 years old or over to be eligible. If your child is between 5 and 16 years of age, you will need to apply for the CEA card on their behalf and must be their parent or legal guardian. There is a £6.00 annual administration charge.

The child with SEND must meet one of the following criteria:

- a. be in receipt of Disability Living Allowance or Personal Independence Payment
- b. be a registered visually impaired person
